

**EUREKA CHARTER TOWNSHIP  
SPECIAL PUBLIC HEARING MEETING MINUTES  
MONDAY, MAY 24, 2021

Supervisor Darcia Kelley, at the Eureka Township Hall, 9322 S. Greenville Road, Greenville, MI, called the Special Public Hearing of the Eureka Charter Township Board to order on Monday, May 24, 2021, at 7:00 pm. After the Pledge of Allegiance, Clerk Ruwersma stated that a quorum was present which included the following Board Members: Supervisor Darcia Kelley, Clerk Linda Ruwersma, Treasurer Cindy Hanson, Trustees Jeremy Austin, Kristen Lower, Tim Johnson, and Brad Kelley. These minutes will not be approved until the June 14, 2021 Regular Board Meeting.

Purpose of this public hearing meeting is to discuss the tentatively approved Water and Sanitary Sewer Service Agreement between the City of Greenville and Eureka Charter Township. Those affected by this contract were sent a letter in regard of the agreement and were encouraged to attend the meeting.

Approximately seven others were in attendance as follows: Eron and Doug Drake, Linda Weger, Mary Sharp, Bruce Rowland, Shawn Wheat, and Doug Hinken. At approximately 7:04 pm the public hearing was open for discussion.

Mr. Doug Hinken, Senior Engineer for the City of Greenville, was invited to the meeting to answer questions for the residents who are utilizing the City of Greenville's sewer system. He answered many questions concerning the grinder pumps, cans, and parts; check valves and alarms; interest rates according to the size and cost of the project; and ownership, maintenance, and availability of the pumps.

Mr. Shawn Wheat, Supervisor of the Greenville City Waste Water Plant, also helped answer any questions from the residents and the Board.

Supervisor Kelley closed the Special Public Hearing and adjourned the meeting at approximately 7:56 pm.
